Goodwin has written a loving but honest memoir of her coming of age as a Brooklyn Dodgers fan in the '50s and about growing up in Rockville Centre, N.Y., a lovely old hometown peopled with Yankees, Giants and Dodgers followers, immigrants from the Bronx, Brooklyn and Manhattan. This is much more than a nostalgic story of baseball; it is a historian's recollection of an era of suburban growth, A-bomb drills, the Rosenbergs' executions and racial integration. It is a story of family and a re-creation of a personal past as rich as Proust's ---and baseball's past, which connects us to each other and to history.
